Construction Scheduled for Midhill Reservoir and Pump Station

A contractor working for Contra Costa Water District soon will begin work to upgrade Midhill Reservoir and Pump Station. Upgrading these facilities will improve reliability of water service in your neighborhood for domestic use as well as firefighting.

Work area

All work will occur on District property. The Midhill Reservoir and Pump Station is located on the ridge east of Heatherleaf Lane.

Schedule

Work will begin as soon as March 6 and be complete by the end of September. Normal work hours for the project are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

What to expect

You may notice increased traffic at the beginning and end of each day. Additional equipment will be left secured onsite throughout the project. At times, a generator will be used during normal work hours. Efforts will be made to limit the noise from the generator. There are no planned water outages for this project. As this is an active construction site, please avoid the project area while work is underway. Please use caution when accessing the trails near the project.

What is being done

Safety and water quality upgrades will be installed on the reservoir. In addition, an inlet/outlet pipe and related valves will be replaced. The pump station will be outfitted with new electrical equipment and instrumentation, and seismic improvements will be made.
